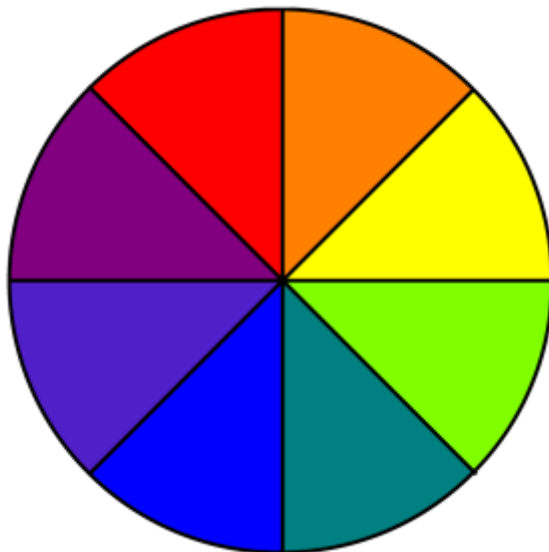

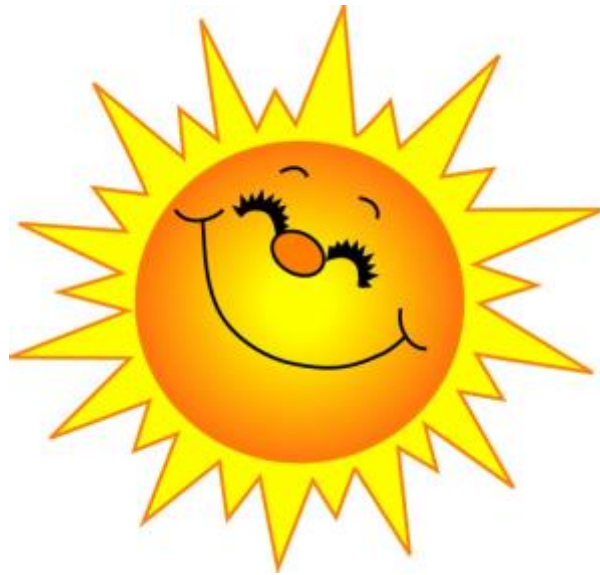


Meet the Teacher
